

Final chance to give us your views

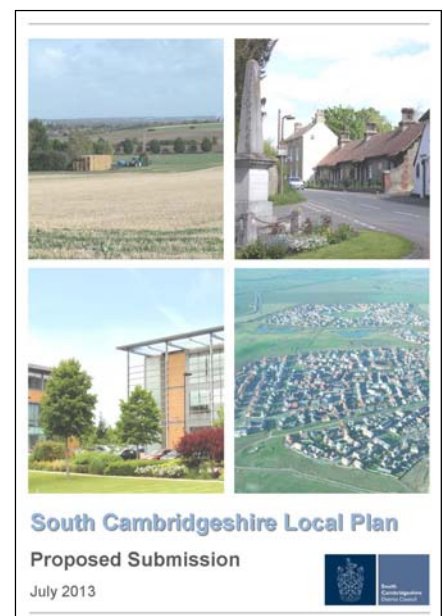
